Past National President Betty DeCleene was called from this life to one in the Great Beyond on Saturday, August 14, 2010 after a courageous battle with Pulmonary Fibrosis which was diagnosed in 2002.

Betty presided at the 60<sup>th</sup> National Convention held in Denver, Colorado. Pre-Convention Board Meeting opened on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of September, 1993. The National Convention was held September 23 through September 26, 1993. Betty's National President's project was "Touch a Child, USA Program of Feed the Children". Donations totaled over \$14,521. During her year as President, Betty traveled through 32 states, attended meetings, luncheons, six Mid-Year conferences and three Regional conventions.

Prior to serving as National President, Betty served our Auxiliary as NCRP, National Treasurer and NVP. At the time of her death she was serving on the 2010 National Convention Committee and Unit Procedures Manual Update Committee. She was a charter member of Packerland Unit 180 and most recently a member of Milwaukee Unit 14.
