LADIES AUXILIARY OF THE FLEET RESERVE ASSOCIATION NATIONAL PRESIDENT'S PROJECT 2017-2018

I have chosen for my National Project for the year 2017-2018, The Alzheimer's Foundation.

I have been an advocate of Alzheimer's since I learned 3 years ago that my Sister was diagnosed with this horrible disease. Just recently there have been 2 famous celebrities that have lost their battle with Alzheimer's, famous Country Singer Glenn Campbell and from our own Knoxville, TN, Pat Summit. Most of you have heard of Pat, the Coach that brought the University of Tennessee Lady Vols to victory time after time. Pat succumbed to early onset of Alzheimer's this past year. Maria Schriver is an advocate for Alzheimer's as well, since a member of her family was stricken with this unforgiving disease.

The number of Americans living with Alzheimer's disease is growing-and growing fast. An estimated 5.5 million Americans of all ages have Alzheimer's disease. Of the 5.5 million Americans living with Alzheimer's dementia in 2017, and estimated 5.3 million are age 65 and have younger-onset Alzheimer's.

Alzheimer's disease is the sixth-leading cause of death in the United States. It is the fifth leading cause of death among those, age 65 and older and a leading cause of disability and poor health. As the population of the United States ages, Alzheimer's is becoming a more common cause of death. It is the only top 10 cause of death that cannot be prevented, cured or even slowed.

In 2016, 15.9 million family and friends provided 18.2 billion hours of unpaid assistance to those with Alzheimer's and other dementias, a contribution to the nation valued at \$230.1 billion.

The costs of health care and long-term care for individuals with Alzheimer's or other dementias are substantial. Dementia is one of the costliest conditions to society. Total annual payments for health care and hospice care for people with Alzheimer's or other dementias are projected to increase from \$259 billion in 2017 to more than \$1.1 trillion in 2050. This dramatic rise includes more than four-fold increased both in government spending under Medicare and Medicaid and in out-of-pocket spending.

As research advances a biomarker-based method for diagnosis and treatment at the earliest stages of Alzheimer's disease is in the process of being developed. I envision a future in which Alzheimer's disease is placed in the same category as other chronic diseases, such as cardiovascular disease or diabetes, which can be readily identified with biomarkers and treated before irrevocable disability occurs.

It may be too late for these changes to benefit my Sister but with the help of my FRA and LA FRA family, we can make a difference perhaps for even a member of your family in the future.

Did you know?

This article is dedicated to the Unit President and Secretary of each Unit. This is not a reprimand. This is just information for all those that always say "well we didn't know", so please read this newsletter to your Unit.

First off, while it is still fresh in our minds, I would like to discuss the delegate sheet. I know, you are quite tired of hearing this, but there are some Units out there that are unaware of how to fill out a delegate sheet or when to mail.

- The delegate sheets must be current and you can find them on the web at www.La-Fra.org.
- If you have a Unit President, Regional Officer, or National Officer or someone who is running for office in your Unit who will be attending the Convention, whether it be a Regional Convention or a National Convention, their name should be on the delegate side of the form and not on the alternate side.
- If you are not sure which members will be attending from your Unit, put down the names of those you are sure will be there as delegates, and others that will possibly attend on the alternate side. Also, list the Chairman as the first person on the delegate side of the form. Then, mark the little box in the middle of the page with an X for 'DID' approve the Chairman to have the authority to add any member of your Unit in good standing to the delegate sheet up to your voting strength at the Convention. This is to assure that the chairman of your delegate sheet (first person on the delegate side) will be able to seat them at the Convention, otherwise they will be counted as a guest.
- Make sure you fill in names of proxies and alternate proxies and these MUST be from another Unit that you have confirmed will be at the Convention. You may also use a Regional or National Officer (just not the President or Secretary 'too busy'). You might think that you do not need a proxy because all 7 of your delegates voting strength will be coming to Convention. However, what if you all decided to go out to breakfast together and (God forbid) that you have a flat tire and couldn't get back on time. Without a proxy or alternate you lose your 7 votes.
- You must send a copy of the delegate sheet to each person listed on the bottom of the delegate sheet 45 days prior to Convention. Why 45 days, because it gives the Regional or National Secretary time to check all delegate sheets for errors, and time for the Convention Committee to make all the badges. The Convention Chairman has way too much to do during Convention, and should not be running to the office three or four times a day to make delegate badges.
- Instructed/Uninstructed is pretty much self-explanatory. You write a letter to the proxy
 you have chosen and instruct them as to who you want them to vote for, and they
 cannot vary from your instructions. If you mark uninstructed, it is typically because you
 trust that they know your desires, and will vote as they feel that your Unit would vote.
- Please do not forget to fill out the very top of the delegate sheet and that all signatures are on the bottom, along with your Unit grouping and how many votes you have for your Unit. Voting Strength and Grouping is provided, to your Unit Secretary, by the NFS by May 15. Ref 809(r)
