The National President Project for 2018-2019 will benefit the National Military Family Operation Purple Camps and Healing Adventures. Operation Purple camps, Healing Adventure Retreats are free to the camper and is open to military service members and their children from all service branches including National Guard and Reserve, Coast Guard, National Oceanic Atmospheric Administration, and the United States Public Health Services Commission Corps; however, priority is given to those children who have a parent that has been wounded, ill or injured (medically retired, medically discharged, active duty and reserve); or will have a parent or guardian deployed during a 15-month deployment "window" (September 2018 – June 2020 includes pre-, during and post deployment phases). If all spaces in these week long camps are not filled with campers who meet the criteria, the remaining camp slots are filled with any eligible military child. Healing Adventures allows the wounded, ill or injured service member and their family to attend a long-weekend experience that will assist each member of the family to adjust to their new norm. Camps are available in multiple locations across the nation to include Alaska and Hawaii. Veterans Day, formerly known as **Armistice Day**, was originally set as a U.S. legal holiday to honor the
end of World War I, which officially took place on November 11, 1918. In legislation that was passed in
1938, November 11 was "dedicated to the cause of world peace and to be hereafter celebrated and known
as 'Armistice Day.'" As such, this new legal holiday honored World War I veterans.

In 1954, after having been through both World War II and the Korean War, the 83rd U.S. Congress -- at
the urging of the veteran's service organizations -- amended the Act of 1938 by striking out the word
"Armistice" and inserting the word "Veterans." With the approval of this legislation on June 1, 1954, Nov.
11th became a day to honor American veterans of all wars.

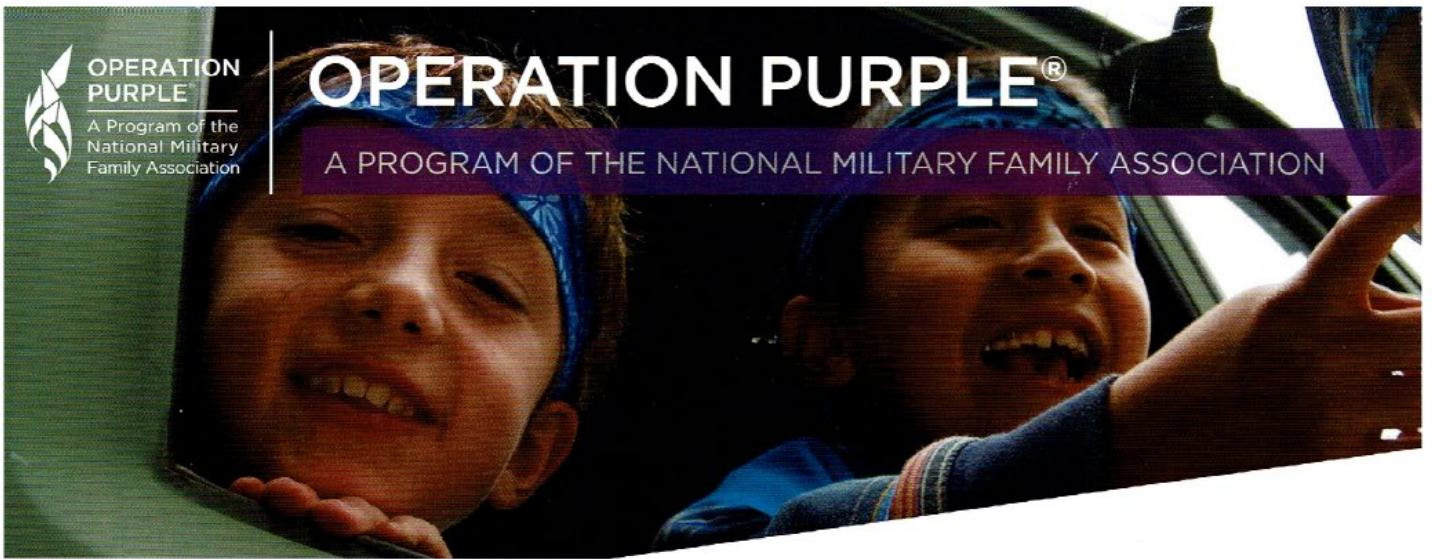

Operation Purple® Camps

At Operation Purple Camp (OPC), over 2,500 military kids per year will connect with peers who have dealt with many of the same things, like frequent moves, a deployed parent, and sometimes a parent’s injury. At camp, kids enjoy kayaking, zip lining, horseback riding, and service activities where they give back to the community. With a waitlist of more than 2,000 kids each year, OPC continues to be a sought-after summer experience. Military Kids Serve, Too!

Operation Purple® Buddy Camp

Buddy Camp is a 2-day program celebrating and appreciating military kids. The goal of buddy camp is to provide a one on one bonding and resiliency-strengthening experience for children ages 5-8 and their adult “buddy”. Buddy Camp is for military-connected children and a same gender adult. The adult can be mom or dad, grandparent or guardian.

Operation Purple Family Retreats®

Our Retreats help families reunite and reintegrate after deployments. Families can unplug and relax and also attend organized activities to help strengthen and renew their relationships. With an average of 300 family applicants each year, and the ability to serve only a quarter of these families, Family Retreats remain paramount to us and to the nation’s military families.

Operation Purple Healing Adventures®

Our Healing Adventures are family retreats designed specifically to help families of wounded, ill, or injured service members. These long-weekend experiences help families adjust to their “new normal,” and rediscover family-fun and togetherness. With an average of 150 applications and the ability to serve only a fourth of these families, Healing Adventures continue to be vital to our mission and the nation’s wounded, ill, or injured families.
