Wow where has the first month gone. I want to thank Unit and Branch 40 for the Welcome New NP reception. For those Units working hard to get in compliance whether it is the EIN, 990N's, standing rules or Unit By Laws thank you. If you are one of the Units whose budget year is July 1 to June 30 and you have not already done so please provide the National Treasurer with your 990N filing for 2017, it was due 15 November. To those who attended ceremonies honoring Veterans and Military Families; USS Cole Memorial, Navy Birthday, Marine Corps Birthday, Veterans Day and the 100th

Anniversary of World War I, remember to send or post your pictures and thank you for honoring those who serve. I especially want to thank Unit and Branch 67 for the warm welcome and hosting of the CLC meeting I recently attended. By the time you read this, I hope your Thanksgiving finds you happy and stuffed with many blessings and the plans for December parties, Christmas, Hanukah, and Kwanza well underway. On December 7th, take a few minutes at 7:55 Aleutian Time to remember the 2400 Americans who perished and 1000 additional who were injured at Pearl Harbor and all those who served in World War II.

I have received several questions about eligibility for membership in the LA FRA and what is the meaning of "at the time of death". Several of you (as was I) may be under the impression that "at the time of death" has to do with specific dates of eligibility changes within the FRA like when the Coast Guard was admitted, or when females became members of the FRA, or when they voted to accept all honorably discharged enlisted Navy, Marine Corps or Coast Guard. After a few phone calls and lengthy discussion with the IRS charities and veteran services exemption representatives, I have been advised that "at the time of death" is interpreted to mean the sea service veteran is deceased and had they not died they would be eligible for membership in the FRA, today. The LA FRA eligibility is to reflect the FRA eligibility. The FRA's C&BL's state "eligibility for membership in the FRA shall be restricted to personnel who have served or are now serving in an enlisted status in the United States Navy, Marine Corps, or Coast Guard, regardless of length of service, including reserve components". The Auxiliary membership eligibility must be from spouses of FRA members, or related to FRA members within two degrees of consanguinity

and not less than 16 years of age (children, parents, grandparents, grandchildren and siblings). Also included are those family members (widows/widowers, children, parents, siblings, grandchildren, grandparents) whose service member has died and had they not died; they would be eligible for membership in the FRA, today, as such therefore C&BL's state "at the time of death". Also, in accordance with the veteran services exempt status, due diligence should be made to determine the family member is a candidate for membership in the LA FRA. If the potential member's family is not known by a current FRA or LA FRA member, for example when a membership drive is conducted, the living sea service member should already be a member of the FRA or recruited and at the same time as the family member. However, if the sponsor is deceased, while LA FRA does not require proof unless eligibility is challenged, service acceptable eligibility documents may be sited but not copied or kept by the Unit. Sighting these documents is not a violation of PII restrictions. However, keeping them or making a copy would be a violation, a. DOD benefits ID card, b. DD-214 Discharge Papers (for the record these were not issued until after Korean War July 29, 1953) c. Official Military Orders -Data from the back of older discharges d. Official Military Service Citations/Awards. e. Letters related to the veteran's military service. f. Certificate from the VA records center in St. Louis, MO- (DD-214 Discharge Papers can be requested online by visiting www.archives.gov). g. official government documents indicating Navy, Marine Corps or Coast Guard enlisted service as the occupation. Remember our membership is declining, and if we are to survive, we should all spread the word and encourage membership, this month is a great time to reach out to members.

Unit Chaplains offer the invocations at the Opening and Closing Ceremonies of meetings takes part in the Initiation Ceremony, Burial Ritual, and Ceremony for the Draping of the Charter, Memorial Service and other Rituals as may be directed. The Chaplain records deaths and reports them to the National Chaplain, Regional Chaplain and the Membership Service Administrator. The Chaplain officiates at the arrangements of the Alter and has charge of the Bible during the meeting and provides spiritual comfort and aid to those in distress. Unit Chaplains are requested to immediately notify the Unit Officers, Regional and National Chaplains and Membership Service Administrator of a deceased member by submitting a complete and accurate Death Notification Form to include the names of the deceased with the name and address of the next of kin. Deceased members are memorialized during Regional Convention and National Convention. Input from Unit Chaplains is vital to ensure that all deceased members are memorialized during the ceremonies and official records are updated by the MSA.

In addition to performing the nonsectarian devotional services as National Chaplain, I look forward to working with the Unit Chaplains to ensure that support is provided for the members in their time of sorrow, illness or distress.

NATIONAL DELEGATE SHEETS (what went wrong in 2018?)

- 1. Many Units did not use the form that was made available either on the website or by mail/email.
- 2. Some Units created their own version of the Delegate Sheet. (this is not acceptable)
- 3. Some Units put their number of Members on the "Number of Votes as of 3/31/20"
- 4. Some Units listed their Proxy/Alternate Proxy, who should not be members of their Unit, in the Alternate Delegate space.

These are just a few of the errors that the Credentials & Registration Chairman, and all others involved, had to contend with at the Convention.

Units are required to use the Current Year's Delegate Form. This form is available on the Website, or you may request one from the NES and it will be either mailed to the Unit or emailed to the Unit Secretary. The names of the six (6) persons who are to receive this form are listed on the back of the form. It clearly states on the form that it is due to reach these persons <u>45 days prior to the convening of the National</u>

Convention. To determine this deadline just count back from the 1st date of the Convention 45 days and this will tell you when the deadline is.

The National Convention Committee makes up name badges based on who is listed on the Delegate Sheet, so misspelled names and listing people who are not attending is a big issue and causes extra work and extra expense for the Committee.
