Although our organization no longer has Blue Books that contain our C&BL's, our Constitution and Bylaws are presently available online via the LA FRA website. I challenge each member to read or reread them. Keep in mind that changes are made from time to time, so we need to continually check for any updates. I would like to thank the members of the Northeast/New England Region for electing me the Regional President for the Auxiliary year 2018-19. Even though I've been here before, it is an honor to serve this region. Besides, the members tell me I must do it "till I get it right".

For several years, both the FRA and LA FRA Regional Presidents of this region are invited to make a presentation at the Awards Ceremony for graduating Cadets at the Coast Guard Academy in New London, CT. There is always a Pass in Review which is a thrilling experience. The Auxiliary presents

the award for the "Most Outstanding Athlete" of that year's graduating class. Also, during the year, Branch 20 in Groton honors the Sailor of the Quarter with a luncheon and ceremony.

The "National Delegate Sheet" is due no later than 45 days from the day Convention starts. (hopefully we will soon have those dates in hand). Count back 45 days from the Pre-Board and that will tell you when the due date is. Be sure the top is filled out correctly and list only Delegates and Alternate Delegates that are going to Convention so that the Convention Committee does time spend time and money making name badges for members who will not be attending. Make sure that names are spelled correctly, and the form is legible. At the bottom right hand corner where it asks for the Unit voting strength, Ref Article 6 Section 809(r) that is the Unit's actual votes per the NFS report that comes out in June. **DO NOT** put the number of members in the Unit, you are only allowed 1 vote per 15 members, not 1 per member. **PLEASE** name a Proxy and Alternate Proxy even if you have members attending. Ref. Article 6, 606(f). Things happen and if your Unit's Delegate is out of the room when a vote is called for, for whatever reason and you do not have a Proxy, your Unit's votes are lost. Name someone you know is attending the Convention and does not belong to your Unit. RPs, RVPs, are the most available because they are most likely going to be there, but you may pick any member in good standing, even an MAL. Ref Article 3, Section 303.
