

(1) A silk lined overseas type of Cap of Navy blue and gold, with crown to be of gold twill, or other suitable material, the apron to be of Navy blue woolen cloth, or other suitable material. The Unit number shall be in front, and, if desired, the Unit geographic location and the highest office held, with years served, shall be on the left side, embroidered in gold. In addition, the name, Ladies Auxiliary Fleet Reserve Association shall be embroidered in gold, on the right side.

WHEREAS the membership voted to acknowledge the doing business as the Auxiliary of the Fleet Reserve Association and

WHEREAS the membership needs to overcome the lack of perception of being less than inclusive and

WHEREAS the membership should embrace the Doing Business As ...with all new hats bearing Auxiliary of the Fleet Reserve Association be it

**RESOLVED** that SR 31 (a) -1 be changed to read: Uniform cap worn by members of the Auxiliary shall be as follows: (1) For female members, A silk lined overseas type of Cap of Navy blue and gold, with crown to be of gold twill, or other suitable material, the apron to be of Navy blue woolen cloth, or other suitable material. The Unit number shall be in front, and, if desired, the Unit geographic location and the highest office held, with years served, shall be on the left side, embroidered in gold. In addition, the name, **Auxiliary of the Fleet Reserve Association** shall be embroidered in gold, on the right side.

**Be it Further Resolved** that all prior hats bearing the name Ladies Auxiliary of the Fleet Reserve Association are grandfathered requiring no one to change their current hat.

#### **NATIONAL CONVENTION 2019**

Memphis, Tennessee has been selected as the site for the 2019 National Convention by the National Committee. The hotel selected is the Crowne Plaza Memphis East at 2625 Thousand Oaks Blvd., Memphis, TN 38118. The dates are from September 22 – 29, 2019. It is located I-240 and Perkins 8 miles from the Memphis International Airport and 16 minutes from downtown & 13 minutes from Graceland.

There is on-site self-parking which is complimentary. Complimentary airport transportation to and from the hotel and within a five-mile radius of the hotel.

Room Rates are \$99.00 (without Breakfast) plus 17.75% tax and the City of Memphis Hotel Tourism Fee of \$2.00 per day or \$109.00 (which includes a Full and Complete Breakfast). Room rates apply for up to three days prior and three days following the convention dates.

The cut-off date for the block of rooms will be held until **Sunday**, **September 1**, **2019**. Reservation requests received after 5:00 PM local time at the hotel on the cut-off date will be accepted based on guest room availability at the Group rate.

*Whereas* Section 806 does not include the overseeing of the Region and Units, to include the current status of EIN and IRS 990, 990-EZ, or 990 e- Postcard filing with IRS, and.

*Whereas,* Presently there is no C&BL, SR, RP Manual of Duties and Responsibilities, UI that requires the Regional President to assist the National Treasurer by monitoring to ensure that the Region and Units of that Region have a current and correct record of the status of EIN, and IRS 990, 990-EZ, or 990 e-Postcard, and that said documents have been provided to the National Treasurer, now therefore be it

**Resolved** that Article 8, Section 806 shall include a Section 806(1) which shall state: The Regional President shall be required to review annually a current record of the Region and Unit status of EIN, IRS 990, 990-EZ or 990 e-Postcard, and fiscal year information and report any discrepancies to the National President and National Treasurer.

This is to certify that this resolution was proposed at a regular meeting of Unit 137 held on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2019 and read debated and adopted by a unanimous vote at a regular meeting of Unit 137 held on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2019 there being a quorum present.

## Article 8 – Duties of Officers and Committees, Section 810 Duties of the National Treasurer Addition Article 8 Section 810(l) additional duties pertaining to Unit and Region EIN and IRS 990, 990 EZ, 990 e-postcard filing.

*Whereas,* Section 810 Duties of the National Treasurer states a list of duties and responsibilities that are required to be performed throughout the course of their term of office and

*Whereas*, Presently there is no C&BL, SR, UI that any National, Regional or Unit Officer is required to maintain a record of the status of EIN, IRS 990, 990-EZ, 990 e-Postcard, or fiscal year of each Region and Unit, and

*Whereas,* Presently there is no C&BL, SR, UI that requires a Region and/ or Unit to provide annually the status of the Region or Unit's EIN, IRS 990, 990-EZ, or 990 e-Postcard, or fiscal year information to the National Treasurer, and

*Whereas*, Presently there is no C&BL, SR that requires the National Treasurer to provide a report stating each Region and Units status of EIN, IRS 990, 990-EZ, or 990 e-Postcard, or fiscal year information to the NBOD and Regional Presidents, and

*Whereas*, in past years, Units have jeopardized their tax-exempt status with the IRS and failed to complete appropriate forms which after three (3) consecutive years of not filing with the IRS the Unit automatically losses its tax-exempt status per IRS regulations, and

Whereas, the reinstatement of an EIN procedure is lengthy and costly to the Region or Unit, now therefore be it

**Resolved** that Article 8, Section 810 shall state; Section 810(1) The National Treasurer shall keep a current record of each Region and Unit status of EIN, IRS 990, 990-EZ, or 990 e-Postcard, and fiscal year information and biannually issue a report to NBOD.

This is to certify that this resolution was proposed at a regular meeting of Unit 137 held on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2019 and read debated and adopted by a unanimous vote at a regular meeting of Unit 137 held on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2019 there being a quorum present.
