Source – Military.com - Military Retirees and Families Are Getting an Extension on ID Card Renewals Military dependent and retiree ID cards set to expire this year will get an automatic extension through September, previously the extension through the end of June 2021 to access benefits using ID cards that expired this year, thanks to an extension of temporary ID card rules issued in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The changes are designed to help military families and retirees avoid visiting base ID card offices during the novel coronavirus pandemic, the memo states. The change was announced in an April 7 memo sent to the service chiefs and signed by Matthew Donovan, Under Secretary for Personnel and Readiness. Typically, cards must be applied for, issued and updated in person up to 30 days before the expiration date at one of the more than 1,600 ID card offices on military facilities worldwide. Cards that do not expire, such as those held by retirees over 65, do not need to be renewed...

But in an effort to reduce crowds at ID card facilities during the pandemic, officials in April issued guidance allowing dependents and retirees to continue to use cards that expired this year to access both military bases and benefits through the end of September. New guidelines issued this month bump that expiration extension into next year. Now, holders of those cards will be able to use them for benefits such as medical care through June 30, 2021, and for base access through March 2021. ID card expiration date will be extended, if a user is still enrolled in DEERS, their ID card will be valid through Sept. 30, regardless of the printed expiration date, the guidance states. If a user is no longer enrolled, their ID card expiration date will not be extended.

Normally, expired ID cards can be confiscated at base gates, and military children over the age of 10 are required to have their own card. Rather than simply confiscate an expired ID, base officials, including gate guards, will first confirm whether the holder is still enrolled in DEERS. The update also extends an age bump for military kids to receive their first ID card. Under normal circumstances, that age is 10. Under the temporary rule, it is 14.

Unlike dependent and retiree ID cards, common access cards (CAC) used by uniformed troops and Pentagon civilian employees must still be obtained in person within 30 days of their expiration date, according to the memo.

If you need a copy of the veteran services manual it can be obtained at irs.gov. https://www.irs.gov/charities-non-profits/other-non-profits/veterans-organizations. Robert's Rules of order 12<sup>th</sup> edition is the current copy and can be obtained at nearly any bookstore or online.

I commonly hear people say "Our Unit doesn't do it that way". The C&BL's clearly points out that Units must follow the National C&BL's, No Unit can operate outside of these regulations or they can be found "not in compliance". All Unit Officer's should be familiar with their duties as prescribed in the C&BL's. If there is something your unit truly believes needs to be updated then I would encourage you to read Article 12 Section 1201 to Sections 1206 for the instructions on how to present a resolution. ### Report from the President

To all our supporters, thank you. It's only through your continued generous support that we're able to honor our promise to the families of our wounded and fallen Special Operations Warriors by providing for their children's education. We could not do this without the support of so many great people, committed to serving others.

Our relatively small force of about 70,000 SOF Soldiers, Sailors, Airmen, and Marines continue to bear a huge burden in the war on terror. These "Quiet Professionals" are routinely deployed in over 70 countries, often engaging in sensitive and dangerous missions that largely go unnoticed by the American public.

In 2019, 40 SOF Warriors died in the line of duty, adding 80 children to our scholarship rolls, bringing the total to over 870 Gold Star kids in the SOWF family.

Our youngest student, Dustin Jr., was born in January 2020, five months after his father was killed in Afghanistan. Our commitment to Dustin is that we will be there to support his education from now until his college graduation in 2043. We will provide for Dustin's pre-school tuition, tutoring from pre-school through college graduation, college preparatory classes, ACT and SAT preparatory classes, college tuition, room board, and more. For those of you who have children or grandchildren, you understand the magnitude of this obligation to not only Dustin, but to more than 870 other children as well.

In addition to scholarships in 2019, the foundation also provided immediate financial assistance to 37 severely combat wounded and injured Special Operations Warriors and their families. This stipend goes toward defraying un-planned, and often significant costs of unexpected hospitalization and recovery periods.

We remain steadfastly committed to being good stewards of the resources we're provided. For the 14th year in a row, Charity Navigator has awarded SOWF its highest Four-Star Rating, placing us in the top 1% of all charities rated.

In 2020, we commemorate our 40th anniversary of our foundation. Our foundation was established by a battlefield promise made by the surviving members of Operation Eagle Claw to the 17 children of the eight Airmen and Marines who made the ultimate sacrifice at Desert One, while attempting to rescue 52 Americans held hostage at the US Embassy in Tehran, Iran. The men of Operation Eagle Claw, those who had "the guts to try," kept their battlefield promise to those children. SOWF's Enduring Promise for the next 40 years and beyond, is to continue to honor Fallen Special Operations Warriors' sacrifices by serving their families and providing for their children's education. SOWF is looking forward to a formal program to address the unique educational requirements of our special needs families. We will also significantly enhance our support by expanding our existing Gold Star educational programs and financial support for severely wounded Special Operators."
