A message from the Constitution & Bylaws Committee Chairman

Bylaws are especially important for an organization like ours as they help in maintaining consistency in the operation of the business. Bylaws are legally binding rules by which the organization is governed. For instance, this past year the LA FRA utilized the sections of our Bylaws to hold election of Officers for the 2020-2021. Over the next several months, Units may wish to propose amendments to the LA FRA Bylaws, Standing Rules or Rituals by writing a resolution. (See Article 12, Section 1205) Resolutions must be received by not less

than 120 days prior to the convening of the annual National Convention.

Please remember, Amendments to Bylaws need to be proposed at a regular meeting of the unit held in one month and then read, debated and adopted by not less than 2/3 vote, at a subsequent regular meeting of the Unit. Amendments to SR and Unit Instruction and Rituals may be proposed, read, debated, and adopted by a majority vote at a single meeting.

When writing a resolution please keep in mind that clarity is of the utmost importance. Those reading it need to be able to understand what you are trying to change/update/propose, why you feel it is necessary to make this change/update/proposal and what the update/change/proposal really will be saying. Do not think that everyone will understand it the way you are stating it. The statement "Clear as Mud" comes to mind. If I can be a help in any way, please feel free to contact me.
