In a June 7 session in the Pennsylvania State House (later Independence Hall), Richard Henry Lee of Virginia presented a resolution with the famous words: "Resolved: That these United Colonies are, and of right ought to be, free and independent States, that they are absolved from all allegiance to the British Crown, and that all political connection between them and the State of Great Britain is, and ought to be, totally dissolved."

Lee's words were the impetus for the drafting of a formal Declaration of Independence, although the resolution was not followed up on immediately.

On July 4, 1776, the 13 colonies claimed their independence from England, an event which eventually led to the formation of the United States.



Prepare and send Regional Delegate forms and Proxy letters. RVP sends the Regional Membership Chairman's Annual Report to the Regional President

National convention:

<u>From Units</u>: National Delegate forms sent to the National President, National Vice President, National Executive Secretary, National Convention Chairman, National Credentials Chairman, and the National Registration Chairman, see the 'Who What and Where Information' sheet. Prepare and send National Proxy letters.

<u>From Regions</u>: First place Unit report. Newly Elected Regional Officers Report sent to the National Vice President, National Executive Secretary, and National Financial Secretary. Send the Regional Chaplains Combined Report to the National Chaplain.

<u>From National Officers:</u> (NP, NVP [includes the National Membership Chairman's report], NFS, NT, <u>JrPNP, Appointee (National Chaplain) and Committee Chairmen (Pilgrimage, Goodwill Ambassador, Scholarship, *FRA Today* Liaison, and Honorary Membership): The *original signature* Annual Report sent by US Postal Service, or equivalent, to the National Executive Secretary by September 19, 2021 and bring two copies to convention.</u>
